THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS MET IN THE OFFICE OF THE BAY COUNTY CLERK AT 9:00 A.M. ON THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 1982.

PRESENT AT THE MEETING WERE: BOARD MEMBERS: DONALD CHEVALIER AND HAROLD MC DOUGALD

AT THIS TIME THE CLERK SWORE IN TWO TEMPORARY MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS: AMBROSE REIF, NAMED BY THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY AND JOHN RADIGAN, NAMED BY THE REPUBLICAN PARTY.

THE CLERK STATED THAT THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS WOULD BE TO ELECT A TEMPORARY CHAIRMAN AND TEMPORARY VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD.

MR. REIF NOMINATED MR. MC DOUGALD FOR TEMPORARY CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS. BEING NO FURTHER NOMINATIONS, MR. RADIGAN MOVED TO CAST A UNANIMOUS BALLOT TO ELECT MR. MC DOUGALD AS TEMPORARY CHAIRMAN OF THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS.

MR. MC DOUGALD NOMINATED MR. CHEVALIER FOR TEMPORARY VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS. BEING NO FURTHER NOMINATIONS, THE CLERK CALLED FOR A VOTE WITH THE RESULTS: 4 YEAS - 0 NAYS. MR. CHEVALIER WAS THEREBY ELECTED TO SERVE AS TEMPORARY VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS.

THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS WERE THEN ASKED TO PROCEED WITH THE CANVASSING OF THE VOTES OF THE GENERAL ELECTIONS HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 1982. THE CANVASSING OF THE VOTES TO BE DONE IN THE COMMISSIONERS' CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE BAY COUNTY BUILDING.
