CANVASS ON DECEMBER 18, 1990

THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS MET ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 18, 1990, AT 4:00 P.M. IN THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONER'S CONFERENCE ROOM. THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS WERE PRESENT:

THE BOARD WAS CALLED INTO SESSION BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO ADDRESS ANY POSSIBLE CHALLENGES WHICH HAD BEEN MADE BY THE PETITIONERS FOR RE-COUNT OF THE 86TH STATE REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

MR. PETERSON INFORMED THE BOARD THAT NO CHALLENGES APPEARED IN ANY OF THE PRECINCTS IN BANGOR, HAMPTON AND MERRITT TOWNSHIPS AND THAT ALL MACHINES WERE RECOUNTED AS REQUESTED WITH THE EXCEPTION OF MACHINE # 73280 IN BANGOR TOWNSHIP (PRECINCT 8) DUE TO THE FACT THAT IT WAS SEALED WITH SEAL NUMBER 769426 AND RECORDED AS SEAL NUMBER 769425.

IN BANGOR TOWNSHIP (PRECINCT 3) THE POLL BOOK INDICATED MACHINE NUMBER 144572 WAS SEALED WITH SEAL NUMBER 346277. THE STATEMENT SHEET RECORDED SEAL 346277 BUT MACHINE 144572 WAS SEALED WITH SEAL NUMBER 346273. IN THIS CASE, THE STATEMENT BOOK AND SEAL CORRESPONDED BY NUMBER, BUT IT DID NOT MATCH THE POLL BOOK AND THEREFORE NOT RECOUNTED.

IN HAMPTON TOWNSHIP (PRECINCT 3) THE INSPECTORS RECORDED THE NUMBERS FOR OPPOSITE MACHINES FROM PROTECTIVE COUNTER AT THE END OF THE DAY, THE MACHINES WERE STILL RECOUNTABLE.

FINALLY, IN HAMPTON TOWNSHIP (PRECINCT 2) THE INSPECTORS TRANSPOSED PROTECTIVE COUNTER IN OPENING STATEMENT OF THE POLL BOOK.

ALL OTHER PRECINCTS APPEARED TO BE RECOUNTABLE AND NO CHANGES WERE FOUND FOR THE 86TH DISTRICT REPRESENTING BAY COUNTY.

BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS AND NO PETITIONERS APPEARED BEFORE THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS, THE MEETING ADJOURNED AT 4:50 P.M.
