

BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS

The Bay County Board of Canvassers met on Wednesday, March 26, 1986.

PRESENT WERE: Donald Chevalier, Harold McDougald, Donald Reetz, Roy Frech and Barbara Albertson, Clerk of the Board.

Clerk Barbara Albertson called the meeting to order and stated that the first order of business was the election of a chairman and asked for nominations from the floor. It was motioned by Don Chevalier that the name of Don Reetz be placed in nomination, supported by Roy Frech, being no other nominations, a unanimous ballot was cast for Don Reetz to serve as Chairman of the Board for a two year term.

The Clerk stated that the next order of business was to make arraignments for the board to check the ballot cans in the Cities and Townships of the County. Harold McDougald suggested that the Board go to the City of Bay City and do all of the City, and if time prevailed that they would continue to do some of the townships, and would complete the balance on Wednesday, April 2, 1986. It was agreed by the board to do so.

The Board checked the following ballot cans with the foregoing results.

CITY OF BAY CITY: Two (2) slats needed, all others approved.

PORTSMOUTH TWP.: Approved.

MERRITT TWP: Approved.

HAMPTON TWP. Approved. The Clerk stipulated that she would be purchasing six (6) new cans and would notify the County Clerk upon arrival, so they can be inspected.

CITY OF ESSEXVILLE: APPROVED.

BANGOR TWP: Approved.


FRANKENLUST TWP: Approved.
