JUNE 3, 1993 TO CANVASS A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD
JUNE 2, 1993.

A SPECIAL ELECTION WAS CALLED FOR BY GOVERNOR ENGLER
FOR AN INCREASE IN SALES TAX FROM 4% TO 6%.

THE PROPOSITION WAS DEFEATED BY 416 VOTES. THERE WERE
14,323 AFFIRMATIVE VOTES IN FAVOR OF THE PROPOSAL AND
14,739 NEGATIVE VOTES AGAINST THE INCREASE.

BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, THE BOARD ADJOURNED UNTIL
TUESDAY, JUNE 15, 1993 AT WHICH TIME THE SCHOOL MIL-
LAGE ELECTIONS WERE TO BE CANVASSED.
