

**BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS**

**CANVASS OF 8/2/94 PRIMARY ELECTION  
HELD 8/3-8/5/94 & 8/8-8/9/94**

THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS MET ON AUGUST 3, 1994 TO BEGIN THE CANVASS OF VOTES CAST DURING THE AUGUST 2, 1994 PRIMARY ELECTION. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 1:00 P.M. AND HELD IN THE GROUND FLOOR COMMISSION CHAMBERS OF THE BAY COUNTY BUILDING.

THE FOLLOWING OBSERVATIONS WERE MADE BY MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS:

**BAY CITY, WARD 2, PRECINCT 1**

Protective counter total and number of voters in the poll book equals 166. The total number of votes for Governor equals 169 which therefore indicates an over-vote of a difference of three (3) votes. There were no explanations in the remarks section of the poll book regarding an overvote for Governor.

The Clerk's return sheet recorded the same figures as noted above.

**BAY CITY, WARD 2, PRECINCT 2**

Write in vote for County Commissioner, District 8, the poll book lists Democrat Rudy M. Howard. The return sheet lists Rudy M. Howard and no political preference.

**BAY CITY, WARD 3, PRECINCT 3**

The closing protective counter figures were not shown on the the Canvass Board return sheet so the figures were taken from the County Clerk's return sheet.

Figures for "Yes" and "No" votes for Proposal C and Proposal D were transposed and the correct figures were determined utilizing the County Clerk's copy of the return sheet.

**BAY CITY, WARD 4, PRECINCT 1**

Noted was the fact it was not necessary to list the serial numbers, machine numbers, and protective counter numbers more than once. The same figures had been repeated three (3) times on the return. (Require the figures for machine used in election).

**BAY CITY, WARD 5, PRECINCT 2**

Column 11B-Total votes should read 16 but the return

sheet reads 26 votes. It was rechecked with County Clerk's copy of the return sheet. Total of 16 votes was the correct figure.

**BAY CITY, WARD 6, PRECINCT 1**

Proposal G-Yes vote total reads 56 but should read 57 votes, this was verified with the County Clerk's return sheet.

**BAY CITY, WARD 8, PRECINCT 1**

Votes for proposals or candidates were not listed on the Canvasser's return sheet. Recorded the figures from the County Clerk's copy of the return sheet.

**BANGOR TWP., PRECINCT 3**

Certificate No. 1-Opening number on protective counter No. 144572 reads 12733 when should reflect 12233.

Votes in column 1B (John Engler) reads 027 and should read 072.

The votes in total column 14A (Howard Wetters) reads 116 but should have read 156, these figures were rechecked with the County Clerk's copy of the return sheet.

**BANGOR TWP., ABSENT VOTERS**

Certificate No. 1-The number registered on protective counter of machine No. 75504 read 01770 on the return sheet. The number should have read 017570. Canvassers referred to the County Clerk's copy of the return sheet and the Canvass Board copy of the return sheet which were both incorrect.

**GARFIELD TWP.**

Only two (2) election inspectors signed Certificate No. 1 and Certificate No. 2. The names were different on each certificate. The poll book listed names of five (5) election inspectors.

**HAMPTON TWP., PRECINCT 4**

Proposal C, total "No" vote read 33 but should be recorded as  $15 + 17 = 32$  votes.

**HAMPTON TWP., PRECINCT 5**

Certificate No. 1-The number registered on the protective counter of machine number 75559 reas 018799. On Certificate No. 2 (closing figure) the protective counter number is listed as 18879. This was a difference of 80 votes while the number of voters was shown as 100.

**KAWKAWLIN TWP., PRECINCT 2**

The opening number registered on protective counter number on machine No. 94742 was listed as 016774. The same number appeared on certificate No. 2 as the close of polls. The same error appeared in the County Clerk's copy of the return sheet.

**MERRITT A.V.'s**

The democratic row for democratic candidates, 12A for George Matousek and row 13A for W. Dennis Hayes had no votes listed for the candidates. There were no "zeroes" entered into confirm no votes were cast.

**MONITOR TWP., PRECINCT 4**

Protective number on machine No. 75558 on Certificate No. 2 was not correct when it was recorded as 02340. The County Clerk's copy was also incorrect. The numbers should be recorded as 23404 in order to equal public counter number 037.

11B William T. Anderson; 12B Joel D. Gougeon; 14B Roland J. Jersevic; 16B Dorothy A. Giffel; 20B Wm. L. Powell.

**PINCONNING TOWNSHIP A.V.**

No votes listed for the following candidates: 5B Spencer Abraham; 14B Carl H. Smith Jr. The County Clerk's copy of the return sheet indicated the same information. Workers should have confirmed the lack of votes in the proper areas with "zeroes".

**WILLIAMS TWP., PRECINCT 2**

The names were not listed on the canvasser's copy of the return sheet for the following candidates: 1A Owen; Stabenow 2A; Wolpe 3A; Jondahl 4A; Pollock 5A; Broadhead 6A; Carr 7A; Ferguson 8A; Kelly 9A; Marlinga 10A; Matousek 12A; Hayes 13A; Nearing 16A; Stalsberg 17A; Studders 18A; Lewandowski 19A; Romney 5B; Abraham 6B; Smith 14B; Gentle 15B.
