The following is a summary of the one (1) school district proposal which shall be considered on the May 7, 2013 ballot:

Essexville-Hampton Public Schools Millage Renewal Proposal

Essexville-Hampton Public Schools Operating Millage Renewal Proposal exempting principal residence and other property exempted by law, 18 mills for 10 years. Full text of the ballot proposal may be obtained at the administrative offices of Essexville-Hampton Public Schools, 303 Pine Street, Essexville, MI 48732, (989) 894-9700 or from the Bay County Clerk, 515 Center Avenue, Bay City, MI, (989) 895-4280.

Electors who wish to vote in the Election must be registered to vote no later than **Monday, April 8, 2013 by 5:00 p.m.** in accordance with Michigan Compiled Law 168.498. Persons who will attain the age of 18 years by election day may also register prior to the deadline.

To register visit your City, Township or County Clerk's office, Secretary of State Branch office, Michigan Office of Human Services, Department of Community Health, the Michigan Jobs Commissioner or any Military Recruitment Center.

Electors who wish to register to vote or change their registration address are advised to contact their City, Township or County Clerk for office hours and other information.

At the Military Recruitment offices for persons enlisting in the Armed Forces.
