This proposal will increase the levy by the Intermediate School District of special education millage by 1 mill.

Shall the 3 mills limitation (currently reduced to 2.8403 mills as required by the Headlee Amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963) on the annual property tax previously approved by the electors of Bay-Arenac Intermediate School District, Michigan, be increased by 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation), for a period of 20 years, 2011 to 2030, inclusive, for the education of students with a disability; the estimate of the revenue the Intermediate School District will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2011 is approximately \$3,496,018.00 from local property taxes authorized herein?

Shall the 1.9417 mills limitation (\$1.9417 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) on the annual property tax previously approved by the electors of Saginaw Intermediate School District, Michigan, for the education of students with a disability be increased by 1.4644 mills (\$1.4644 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation), for a period of 20 years, 2011 to 2030, inclusive; the estimate of the revenue the Intermediate School District will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2011 is approximately \$7,247,800.00 from local property taxes authorized herein?

BEAVER TOWNSHIP FIRE TRUCK/EQUIPMENT MILLAGE INCREASE PROPOSAL

Shall the 15 mill tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Beaver Township imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution be increased for said Township by .75 mill (\$.75 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for the period of three (3) years, December 1, 2012 through December 1, 2014 inclusive, for the purpose of purchasing a new fire tanker truck and other equipment; and shall the Township levy an increase in millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$57,000.00?

BEAVER TOWNSHIP FIRE SERVICE MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall the previously voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Beaver Township be renewed at 1.0 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for the period of ten (10) years, December 1, 2012 through December 1, 2021 inclusive, for fire protection service in Beaver Township; and shall the Township levy a renewal in millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$76,000.00?
