Proposal: The following is a summary of the six (6) state, three (3) county, one (1) school and four (4) local proposals to be considered on the November 6, 2012 ballot:

STATE PROPOSAL 12-1

A referendum on Public Act 4 of 2011- The Emergency Manager Law

STATE PROPOSAL 12-2

A proposal to amend the State Constitution regarding Collective Bargaining

STATE PROPOSAL 12-3

A proposal to amend the State Constitution to establish a standard for Renewable Energy.

STATE PROPOSAL 12-4

A proposal to amend the State Constitution to establish the Michigan Quality Home Care

Council and provide collective bargaining for in-home care workers.

STATE PROPOSAL 12-5

A proposal to amend the State Constitution to limit the enactment of new taxes by State Government.

STATE PROPOSAL 12-6

A proposal to amend the State Constitution regarding construction of international bridges and tunnels.

Bay Medical Care Facility Millage Proposal

This proposal would replace previous medical care facility millage which expired with the 2011 tax levy for the operation, maintenance and capital costs of the Bay Medical Care Facility.

Historical Preservation Millage Proposal

This proposal is a continuation of the original .1 mill previously approved by the voters to be used to preserve Bay County's unique history, educate citizens, conduct projects, and operate and maintain a museum for a period of 20 years.

Senior Citizens Millage Proposal

This proposal is for a .3 of a mill for a period of five (5) years for senior citizens' programs and related facilities. (Separate from the .50 mill up for renewal in 2015)

Fraser Township Road Millage Increase Proposal

This proposal is for an increase of 1 mill for four years for the purpose of construction, maintenance and improvement of local public roads in Fraser Township for a period of 4 years.

Hampton Township Road Millage Renewal Proposal

This proposal will renew the .65 mill previously voted millage for the purpose of constructing, maintenance, or improvements of publicly owned roads, highways, streets and parking lots in Hampton Township for a period of ten years.

Kawkawlin Township Road Millage Increase Proposal

This proposal is for an increase of 1 mill for four years for the purpose of construction, maintenance and improvement of local public roads in Kawkawlin Township for a period of 4 years.

Merritt Township Road Millage Renewal Proposal

This proposal will renew the 1.5 mill of previously voted millage for the purpose of maintaining and improving public roads in Merritt Township for a period of five years.

Delta College Millage Renewal Proposal

This proposal will permit Delta College to continue the current levy of millage for college purposes by renewing the College's authority to levy 0.4864 mill previously approved by the voters, which will expire after the 2015 levy for a period of 8 years.

Electors who wish to vote in the General Election must be registered to vote no later than **5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 9, 2012** in accordance with Michigan Compiled Law 168.498.

At the specified agency for clients receiving services through the Michigan Office of Human Services, the Department of Community Health, Michigan Jobs Commissioner and some offices of the Commission for the Blind. At the Military Recruitment offices for persons enlisting in the Armed Forces.

By Mail:

By obtaining and completing a Mail-In Voter Registration Application and forwarding it to the election officials as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline, **Tuesday, October 9, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.**
