SAGINAW — The Saginaw County Apportionment Commission has picked County Clerk Susan S. Kaltenbach as its chairwoman.

The five-member commission met today for the first time in a decade to outline how it will handle 2010 U.S. Census data to determine district boundaries of the 15-member Board of Commissioners.

Prosecutor Michael D. Thomas, Treasurer Marvin D. Hare, County Democratic Chairwoman Garnet Lewis and County Republican Party Chairwoman Helene Wiltse also serve on the panel.
