

## BAY COUNTY PARENTING TIME POLICY SCHEDULE B

In a family where the oldest child is between the ages of 3 years to the completion of kindergarten, the parenting time schedule is as follows. This schedule shall be followed unless otherwise mutually agreed upon in writing, signed by both parties and submitted to the Friend of the Court office.

### Regular Parenting Time

1. Each parent shall have alternating weekends from 6 p.m. on Friday until 6 p.m. on Sunday.
2. The non-custodial parent shall have one evening each week for a minimum of two (2) hours, for example on Wednesday from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m.; Work schedules may require a different day and/or time period.
3. Following the non-custodial parent's first parenting time weekend in each month, the non-custodial parent shall be entitled to an additional five-day period for a total of seven days. This one-week period each month shall extend from Friday at 6 p.m. until the following Friday at 6 p.m. The five days are not to interfere with the child(ren)'s regular day care arrangements or nursery school programs. If the non-custodial parent cannot utilize the child(ren)'s day care provider or nursery school program, a petition may be filed with the Court to modify these arrangements. The non-custodial parent shall be responsible for any child care expenses incurred during this period of time. These one-week periods qualify for child support abatement if there is such a provision in the current child support order. During this time, the custodial parent shall have one Wednesday parenting time period from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. if the child is not out-of-town for a vacation.

### Periods of Extended Parenting Time

Upon the oldest child of a family completing kindergarten, Schedule "C" of the Bay County Parenting Policy will be implemented.

### Miscellaneous Information.

1. The alternating weekend parenting time schedule is to be exercised throughout the entire calendar year. Only by written mutual agreement signed by both parties and submitted to the Friend of the Court office shall the weekend rotation be changed.
2. A general itinerary and emergency telephone number shall be provided to the other parent if an out-of-town vacation is planned.

3. The parenting time schedule will be exercised in a prompt manner. In the event of an unforeseen circumstance, a 30-minute delay is allowed for picking up and returning the child(ren).
4. Transportation for parenting time shall be shared equally between the parties. The parent receiving the child(ren) shall be responsible for picking up the child(ren) from the other parent's residence.
5. Holiday parenting time according to the attached Bay County Holiday Parenting Policy.
