







Measure of Weight Among Bay County Adults







Alcohol Use - Bay County






Percent of Obese and Overweight Youth







Smoking Behaviors Among Youth Bay County 2011-2012




Alcohol Use Among Youth Bay County 2011-2012








Patient To Physician Ration






