Public Act 228 of 2020 allows for the governing boards of a "public body" to hold meetings electronically, provided the public body establishes procedures for the electronic meetings. Starting on January 1, 2021, the act establishes specific limitations on attending remotely: local or statewide state of emergency, declaration of disaster, medical condition, and military duty.

In compliance with Public Act 228 of 2020, BCERS and VEBA Board Meetings for 2021 may be held electronically. BCERS and VEBA will provide notice to the public that the member(s) will be attending electronically. The notice will be posted at least 18 hours in advance of the meeting on the BCER AND VEBA website and the notice will provide information on how members of the public may participate in the meeting electronically.

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
